You will need to download the Arbor Parent App. The logo looks like this:

Enter your email address and then click on forgotten password. They will send a link to your email address to allow you to reset a password of your choice.

Once the booking system is live you will be able to book an appointment in your Arbor account under *Guardian Consultations*, by selecting your preferred date.

If you experience any problems trying to book an appointment please contact the school office. Please bear with us as this is a new system and there could be teething problems.



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
<u>Christmas Pantomime 2025—Snow White</u>

It is great to see that some parents have already paid—thank you.






