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Useful Information for Next Year

Infant Fruit:	Children in Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 receive free fruit as part of a Government scheme.
Junior Fruit Snack	Children in KS2 will receive a free piece of fruit as a snack for break time.
Milk:	Milk is only available for children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. If your child is entitled to Pupil Premium funding they will automatically receive milk. If you do not want your child to receive milk please let the office know. If your child is NOT entitled to Pupil Premium funding and you did not order them milk this year, please register for milk on the Cool Milk website www.coolmilk.com or contact them on 0800 3213248. All children in school have a beaker so that they can access drinking water during the day.
PE kits:	All children need PE kits in school. Children need to have a pair of pumps for indoor use – not trainers as these can mark the hall floor. These pumps can also be used outdoors, although you might prefer to send in an old pair of trainers for this purpose. From a hygiene point of view, it is important that children have a change of footwear for PE. Please don't spend a lot of money on a pair of trainers for outdoor PE.

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
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Christmas Pantomime 2025—Snow White
