Admission to Reception Class & Secondary School 2024

The online admission form for admission to Reception Class and Secondary schools in September 2024 is now accessible using the following link:- https://blackburn.gov.uk/SynergyWeb/Parents/appsummary.aspx If you have a child due to start primary school next September (born between 1st September 2019 and 31st August 2020), please ensure you complete the online admission form. The closing dates are:-

Secondary Schools – 31st October 2023 Primary School – 15th January 2024

It is extremely important that these deadlines are met as it can affect your chance of being offered your first choice school.

If you are applying for your child's secondary school place, please read your chosen school's admissions criteria carefully as last year we had some very disappointed pupils and parents who did not get accepted into their first choice of secondary school.

If you do not have access to the internet please contact the school office to arrange an appointment to complete the application online.

- The grand final will take place in February 2024 at Buckingham Palace! The top 50 finalists will be invited, along with a parent or carer. The event will be featured in a special 500 Word programme with The One Show, on World Book Day on 7 March
- The two gold winners will receive the height of Sir Lenny Henry in books, as well as 500 books for their school. The two silver winners will receive the height of Her Majesty, Queen Camilla in books and the two bronze winners will receive the average height of a 7 or 11 year old in books.


