<u>Updated attendance policy.</u>

Our attendance and punctuality policy has been updated in line with DfE statutory guidance. Our policy can be found here: https://staidansblackburn.co.uk/key-information/attendance

The main changes include:

- Supporting families to attend school every day, on time (8:50am)
- 5 days off school unauthorised can lead to a fine
- Lates can now also lead to unauthorised absences 10 lates can lead to a fine and prosecution
- All schools now have to provide a sickness return to the local authority if a pupil has had 15 days of illness
- If lates and absences continue and voluntary 'support first' has not been effective, we will work with the local authority, to formalise and intensify the support with meetings
- Please be aware that the new legislation does not allow schools to authorise any holidays in term time

If you have any concerns about your child's attendance, please do not hesitate to contact either myself or Mrs Trencher so that we can offer support for your child and family.



E-commerce company, Amazon, has told all staff they need to return to the office five days a week next year, ending the option to work from home. In a message to all workers, Chief Executive Andy Jassy said the company expected everyone to be in the office full time (apart from some exceptions) from 2nd January, 2025. Amazon's new policy is very different from the UK government's approach, which is to make flexible working a right for employees, as promised in a new law proposal, due to be announced later this year.
