Course Evaluation Criteria

- Pupils can say 'hello' and 'goodbye' with some accurate pronunciation.
- Pupils can say 'please' and 'thank you' with some accurate pronunciation.
- Pupils can say most, if not all, of the numbers 1-10 with a low level of accurate pronunciation.
- Pupils can answer the questions introduced in this unit in sentences with a low level of accuracy.
- Pupils can accurately say all numbers 1-10.
- Pupils can answer the questions introduced in this unit in accurate sentences.

Course Overview: Pupils will be introduced to the Spanish language by learning basic greetings and gaining an understanding of the numbers 1-10.
