Course Evaluation Criteria

- 8. Pupils can say all the tens between 20 and 50 and some numbers in-between them with inconsistent accuracy.
- 9. Pupils can accurately ask and answer the question 'Do you have brother or sisters?" in full sentences.
- 10. Pupils can say the numbers 20-50.

Learning Outcomes

Course Overview: Pupils will be learning about family and how to introduce members of their family in Spanish whilst having the opportunity to watch Spanish stories and listen to native speakers.

Learning Outcomes: Pupils will learn vocabulary relating to family and work in pairs to have short conversations in Spanish about their families, using the new vocabulary learnt.
