Week 1 Neil Armstrong was the first man to walk on the moon in 1969.

Week 2 Neil Armstrong was born in America in August 1930.
He was part of the Navy in 1949.
He became an astronaut in 1962.
He was the first man to land on the moon in July, 1969.
He died in August 2012.

Week 3 Amelia Earhart was the first woman to fly non-stop and alone across the Atlantic ocean.

Week 4 Amelia Earhart was born in America in 1897.
She went on her first aeroplane ride in 1920.
She earned her pilot's licence in 1923.
She became the first woman to fly solo non-stop across the Atlantic ocean.
In 1937, she set off a flight around the world and 17 days later she was declared lost at sea.

Week 5 Neil was the first man to walk on the moon and Amelia was the first woman to fly non-stop alone across the Atlantic ocean.
