

PE

PE lessons will be on a Wednesday this half term. Our focus will be on throwing and catching. This will involve working individually, with a partner and as a team.

Please make sure that your child has their PE kit in school and that all piercings are removed or covered with plasters.

Computing

This half term we will be focusing on computer Science. This will involve creating a set of instructions called Algorithms. We will use the Kodable app to make our characters move around the screen and learn how to make them repeat set moves.

PSHE

During our PSHE lessons, we will be looking at keeping safe and managing risks. This will include looking at who can keep us safe both at home and outside.

Reading

Reading books: Your child will bring one decodable book home every Thursday. This will be the book they have worked on in their Reading Practice Sessions at school that week. These need to be returned on Mondays ready for the sessions in school that week.

Books We Know: Your child will bring home a book they know each week. They will have read these books at school so sit back and enjoy them telling you a story. It will be their responsibility to look after it and they must remember to bring it to school each Monday in order to exchange it for a new book.

Homework

Every Friday, each child will bring home a piece of homework. This will be either Maths or English. Homework must be completed by the following Thursday.

Maths

The maths topics we will cover are:

- Counting in different multiples—10
- Numbers 1-20 in words
- Part whole models
- Addition
- Subtraction
- Number bonds to 10



English

This half term, we will be reading the book Zog by Julia Donaldson.

We will continue to focus on punctuation including full stops, capital letters and finger spaces. The children will also learn to consider how a character is feeling and create interesting vocabulary to show this. To finish off the book, the children will innovate the story to create their own version of Zog.

Science

In science we will be finishing off our Animals including humans topic, before moving onto materials. We will explore different materials and their properties. The children will also perform a number of experiments and learn how to conduct a fair test.

Geography

This half term we will be looking at geography of the local area and identifying the countries and the capital cities in the UK. We will be able to answer the question. 'Where do I live?'

RE

In RE we will be exploring bible stories and talking about Christmas. We will look at the importance of this festival and how Christians celebrate it.
