The maths topics we will cover are:

- multiplying 2-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers,
- dividing 2-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers,
- converting pounds and pence,

We will be linking our writing to our History topic about Ancient Egypt. We will be focusing on non-fiction writing and will produce a set of instructions, a newspaper report and a non-chronological report. We will be finding out about the Ancient Egyptians. We will focus on what life was like over 5000 years ago and discover what everyday life was like for the men, women and children and what the houses they lived in were like.



We will be studying 'Animals including Humans'. The focus will be on discovering what is required for a healthy diet, which nutrients our bodies need and which foods we can get them from. We will also learn that animals cannot make their own food .



We will be using Bible stories to discover what Jesus was like and how he changed the lives of many people. We will then move onto studying significant people in Islam and Judaism.
