Homework- Expectations at Home

Please support your child by making sure that you hear your child read at home at least twice a week and that homework tasks or spellings are completed and returned on time. Each class's expectations of homework can be found on their class newsletter.

Are you on Class Dojo?

Class Dojo is a free app and is our main source of communication between teachers and parents. Teachers share photos and videos of their class daily. You can also communicate with your child's class teacher and share updates, photos and videos from home. If you need a login please ask Mrs Harrison or your child's teacher. Thank you.



Covid-19 Testing – Walk-In Centre

If you or your child shows symptoms of COVID-19 please visit the walk-in centre to be tested. Once you have been tested you will receive your results usually within 48 hours by text or email. You will need to show this test result to the school office team, it is a negative result, your child will be able to return to school. If it is a positive result, then you will need to follow the government guidelines for self-isolation.

Walk-in testing units have been set up in the following location.

• Blackburn College car park. This site operates between 8am–8pm seven days a week.

You are asked to follow public health guidelines around social distancing and face coverings when you visit the walk-in site.

After School Clubs

We are working hard to try and have some afterschool clubs running in a Covid safe way. We will send out afterschool club letters once we know which clubs we can safely run. Thank you for your support in this matter.

School Drop Off and Collections

Due to the current situation with Covid-19 we are only able to allow **1 parent/carer** on the school yard to drop off children and to collect them after school. This is to prevent gatherings in the yard and to adhere to the government social distancing guidelines that have been put in place to keep you and your children safe. If you are applying for your child's secondary school place, please read your chosen school's admissions criteria carefully as last year we had some very disappointed pupils and parents who did not get accepted into their first choice of secondary school.
