Breakfast Club



Our Breakfast Club starts at **8.00am** to **8.40am** each morning. Please DO NOT send your child before this time as there is no one available to supervise them. Your child will receive a bowl of cereal, toast and a drink. All children must be booked in before coming to Breakfast Club, please speak to the school office team to add your child to the list as we only have 30

places available. Breakfast Club costs £1.00 per day (payable via ParentPay) unless your child qualifies for pupil premium.

Punctuality



There have been a number children arriving after 8.50am and this affects pupil progress. Please ensure that your child(ren) arrive at 8.50am every morning to avoid disruptions to their lessons and the administrative running of the school. Children can come into class from 8.40am ready to start their school day. School is required by law to pass names of persistent absentees to the Local Authority who may issue a penalty notice.

<u>Parking on 'zigzags'</u>

We have noticed that some people are parking on the 'zigzags' outside school when picking up and dropping off children in the morning and evening. Please do not park on these 'zigzags' as it makes it very dangerous for children trying to cross the road. If you get dropped off or picked up by a taxi please remind the taxi driver that they are not allowed to park on the 'zigzags'. Thank you for your co-operation in this matter - the safety of our children is our top priority.



Labelling school uniform



Can I please remind you to write your child's name in their school jumpers, tops, coats and in their PE kit, especially in Reception Class & KS1. It is extremely important that this is done to avoid items of uniform going missing and items being returned to the correct child. It is the responsibility of all junior pupils to look after their own uniform and belongings; **the school cannot be held responsible for missing items.** Please ensure that your child is aware of this to avoid any upset. Thank you for your support with this.

Bikes and Scooters in School

If your child arrives to school on a bike or scooter they <u>MUST</u> bring a suitable lock and chain to secure them. All bikes and scooters must be kept in the kitchen entrance yard area **BEFORE** the school gates are locked. We are unable to keep the bikes and scooters in school. If your child arrives late when the gates are locked then their bike/scooter will need to be locked on the gates at the front of the school. All bikes and scooters are left at owners own risk and school cannot take responsibility for any loss or damage.
