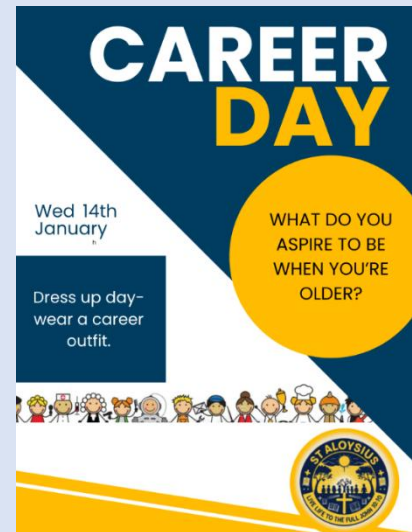


Career Day
