To ensure the environment is well maintained and the children are kept safe please remember to follow the rules...

- ⇒ No running in the garden.
- ⇒ Keep to the paths. These will either be marked out with a log border or will be the areas where the grass is kept cut.
- ⇒ The flowers in the garden are slowly establishing themselves. Do look and observe the colours and types of plant but **do not** pick the flowers from the garden.
- ⇒ The allotment has lots of fruits and vegetables growing in it. Please only dig in designated areas.
- ⇒ The pond area **must always be supervised**. When not in use this area **must be kept locked**. (EYFS please note: a maximum of 5 children should enter the pond area with one adult at a time.)
- ⇒ The fire pit circle is being used and is therefore at risk of containing hot ash for long periods after the fire has been extinguished. Children are therefore **not permitted** to access this area. If it is being used as a sitting area for whole class discussions please ensure children only ever enter and leave from the back of the circle and never cross the circle.

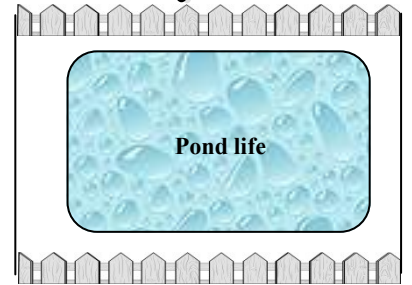

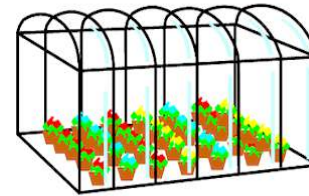

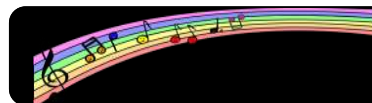
