

Hoy Class have enjoyed playing team games in our PE sessions, this week the sun shining meant we were able to enjoy playing badminton outside






The Glens

KS4 students went to Aston on Trent and walked by the canal and through woods. We even got lucky enough to be able to help a canal boat through the lock!




















The Highlands



The Highlands have had another wonderful week enjoying the hot weather! Taransay class have enjoyed doing their science experiments outdoors. Learners have continued their work on 'forces' by creating their own parachutes and were asked to predict whether the parachute would fly up or fall to the ground when dropped from a height in an introduction to gravity. Students really excelled with their critical thinking skills and fine motor skills.

Students in Iona class were learning about public and private spaces for their RSE session. Learners were asked to sort pictures of public spaces, such as the bus or the park, from private places, such as their bedroom or the bathroom. Students did very well to listen to staff and complete the activity with maturity.

All learners in the Highlands also enjoyed a recorded concert of the Wizard of Oz. Students laughed along and played their own instruments!












Therapy Input





Apply Now for September School Transport

A reminder to parents; if your child is moving up to Post 16 education in September (Year 11, 12 and 13) please complete your child's home to school transport application as soon as possible

At St Andrew's Academy, most of our students are dropped off and collected from school via mini bus or taxi. These services are provided and arranged independently by Derby City Council or your child's Local Authority (if outside of the City Council). **If your child will be moving up to post-16 education**, now is the time to apply.
