We've had a lovely time at Mr Pumpkin today, as part of our topic on farming and learning about how vegetables grow.
















KS4

Therapy Input





Some students from Bute class enjoyed accessing the therapy room as part of their PE lesson.

Different activities to engage their core muscles, as well as hand eye coordination and balance were put out for them to turn take.


We finished the session in the sensory room exploring sensory lights and completing a deep breathing activity.






