In memory of Erin Alger



Those of you who have been with us for over 3 years will no doubt be aware of a very special young lady called Erin Alger. Erin came to us from Springfield ERS in Year 7 and started St Andrew's in the Willows. It's fair to say she was full of character and loved school. She loved to wear a woolly hat and crocs and would always ask everyone who was in their family. She could remember every one of your family member's names, no matter how many names you shared! Erin was a big fan of Haribo and had many cherished soft toys, including Benji the puppy. School was a happy place for both Erin and Nikki, Erin's mum, and the work the staff team did with them as a family will always be a source of genuine pride for me as the Head Teacher and source of strength and connection for Nikki.

Sadly, in Year 9, Erin had a short battle with a serious illness and lost her life. Erin touched the lives of those staff fortunate enough to share her journey at St Andrew's far beyond what my words can convey. This week, I welcomed Nikki back into St Andrew's to reconnect and discuss ways in which we can support Erin's legacy and Nikki's future plans as we approach what would have been her 18th birthday on the 15th of November.

We have plans for an installation into the new Art room as Erin loved to draw and colour. Also, Nikki is in the process of writing a series of children's stories about Erin with the royalties planned to be spent on a caravan to provide holidays for disadvantaged young people with additional needs. Erin loved being in a caravan, not for the location, as she would have been happy on her drive, but just the experience of being in a caravan.

I'm sharing this information now as we plan to celebrate Erin in the coming weeks and I'm keen that our school community, old and new, know who Erin is and the special place that she will always have in our school.






The Glens






KS4

In maths in Jura this week we have been sorting clothes into big and small light and dark and matching. Developing our functional skills.












Therapy Input




Makaton- Sign of the Week
