








# **Hoy Class**

# Duke of Edinburgh

Last Thursday and Friday was the Bronze groups' final Duke of Edinburgh expedition and was the first time the Bronze group had the opportunity to camp offsite. They walked an 8 mile route before getting to the campsite near Elvaston Castle, camping for 1 night before walking the route back to school the following day. Over the course of our 3 expeditions, the students have walked around 32 miles in total (not counting all of the training miles that came before hand) as well as helping to cycle the 300 miles to raise money to fund this.

The students (and staff) in Barra class have found these expeditions to be a rollercoaster of emotions and have managed to smash each mile with sheer determination, gritted teeth and lots of encouragement and positivity. It has been an absolute pleasure to see how the students have risen to the challenge and overcome the challenges along the way. We are so proud of how far they have grown as young people since starting our training in September.
