# Attendance

St Andrew's Academy is supported by the Derby City Council Senior Education Welfare Officer (SEND) Adele Jones. Working alongside Adele, the Senior Leadership team use all the information we have available from registers, class teams and other sources to identify pupils who fall below the recognised Good Attendance rate.

The sole intention for this process is to then contact families to discuss how we can work together and help to raise the attendance levels.

There are many clear reasons why good attendance is the corner stone of great progress and a fulfilling educational career.

Research shows that missing 10 percent of school, or about 18 days in most schools, negatively affects a student's academic performance.

This is an ongoing service throughout the whole year. Should you receive a letter regarding your young person's attendance, please know that this aim is to work together. The letter will contain the legalities and information about fines. Please be assured that, whilst fining is a possibility, that this is the very last outcome that we will explore and that our desire is that it is avoided through collaboration and sensitive consideration of every individual need.


