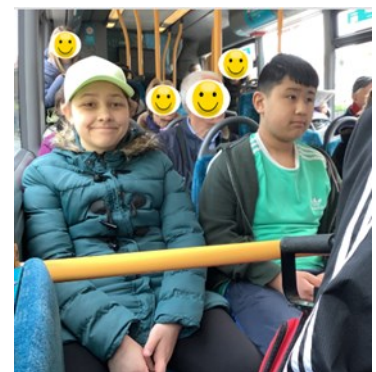
Lewis Class

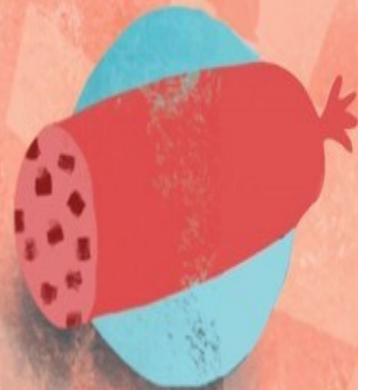
