Science

Our Science this half term will be focusing on the circulation system in humans and animals. The children will learn how the blood travels around the body and its role in health. Part of our learning will investigate the links between exercise, diet and good health.

English

Our English this halt term will focus on the book 'How the whale became and other stories' by Ted Hughes. We will use the text to plan our own folk style narrative on how different creatures came to be. The stories explore how our experiences shape our personalities and make us unique.

To link with our Geography unit, our non-fiction will highlight current issues around pollution in the oceans and how we can be agents of change in a

Positive way. The children will write persuasive argument based on the use of single-use plastics and how they impact the natural world.

In poetry, we will read and perform some of Roger McGough's 'Happy Poems' collections which has an upbeat and joyful prose that will amuse and inspire the children.

<u>P.E</u>

In PE, the children will be learning new dance moves, exploring different movements and creating a routine to music. Our other PE lesson will focus on football and developing our core skills alongside working as a team. The children will build their communication skills and begin to look at different tactics and approaches.

R.E

In Religious Education, the children will be identifying the core beliefs of Islam by exploring the five pillars. They will investigate how the five pillars of Islam affects the daily lives of Muslims around he world and begin to make links with their own beliefs and viewpoints.

Maths

Our focus this half term will be on Fractions. The children will learn to convert between mixed and improper fractions. They will build on their division and multiplication knowledge by finding equivalent fractions and begin to add and subtract with them.

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Autumn Term 2 Curriculum – Class Three

Geography

For our Geography unit the class are investigating why are oceans matter to us. The children will build on locational knowledge by identifying different features of our oceans. Our focus will be on the impact of humans on our oceans and what measures we can take to protect both our water and marine life.

Music

In Music the children will be creating compositions for animations based around a theme-mountains. They will start to link music to how it makes them feel around create their own melodies and rhythms to try and impact others emotions.

Computing

Our Computing unit this half term will introduce the children to basic web page design. We will use our learning about the oceans to create an informative webpage that we will be able to share through our website.

<u>French</u>

In French the children will be learning language about inside the home. They will be able to identify French words for everyday items around the home and begin to use them in conversation. To build on their current knowledge, they will start too use propositions to say where you would find items around the house.

PSHE

The class will be learning about the importance of relaxation and sleep; understanding how to cope with failure; learning how to set goals and how to achieve goals. Looking at healthy meals and ingredients; learning about different emotions and possible ways of dealing with a difficult situation.

D&T

In our Design and Technology unit we will look at what makes food healthy and the impact that has on our body. The children will adapt a recipe to add in healthier choices before preparing and cooking it. They will learn basic preparation techniques using knives, peelers and graters.
