Science

Our topic is all about Materials, Rocks and Soils. We will explore the physical properties of rocks and soils and learn about fossil formation.



English

Autumn Term 1 Curriculum – Class 2

History

How have children's lives changed?
Children will make inferences and deductions from primary and secondary sources to explain why children needed to work, what jobs they had and what the working conditions were like. Children will also identify diseases and how effective treatments were.

Music

Our topic in Music is all about ballads. Children will explore the key features, perform a ballad using actions, sing in time and tune, retell a summary and write their own verse with rhyming words to perform.

Computing
