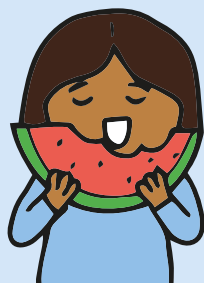

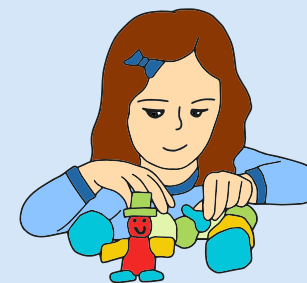

## Pronouns

<b>je</b>	I
<b>tu</b>	you (singular and informal)
<b>il</b>	he/it (masculine singular)
<b>elle</b>	she/it (feminine singular)
<b>nous</b>	we
<b>vous</b>	you (plural or singular formal)
<b>ils</b>	they (masculine plural)
<b>elles</b>	they (feminine plural)

Irregular verbs do not follow a standard spelling pattern.  
These are two key irregular verbs:

## être - to be

<b>je suis</b>	I am
<b>tu es</b>	you are (singular and informal)
<b>il est</b>	he is
<b>elle est</b>	she is
<b>nous sommes</b>	we are
<b>vous êtes</b>	you are (plural or singular formal)
<b>ils sont</b>	they are (masculine plural)
<b>elles sont</b>	they are (feminine plural)

## avoir - to have

<b>j'ai</b>	I have
<b>tu as</b>	you have (singular and informal)
<b>il a</b>	he/it has
<b>elle a</b>	she/it has
<b>nous avons</b>	we have
<b>vous avez</b>	you have (plural or singular formal)
<b>ils ont</b>	they have (masculine plural)
<b>elles ont</b>	they have (feminine plural)

## Regular -er verb endings

<b>je</b>	-e	<b>nous</b>	-ons
<b>tu</b>	-es	<b>vous</b>	-ez
<b>il/elle</b>	-e	<b>ils/elles</b>	-ent
