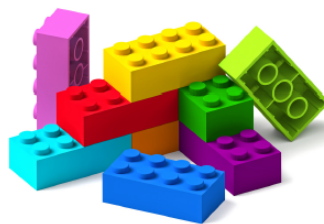

We shall be visiting school on Monday 17th November 2025 to deliver the Nasal Flu spray programme to those pupils in Reception – Year 6. If you have not done so and would like your child protected against Flu please complete the consent form by 10am on Thursday 13th November 2025 when the online consent portal will close. If there have been any changes to your child’s health 14 days before to the vaccination date YOU MUST contact the immunisation team on 0300 124 0366 as your child may not be well enough to receive the vaccination.
