

TOPIC

In history, Willow will seek to answer the question: 'why do we have Remembrance Day?'

ART/DT

Willow will be exploring painting and mixed media, specifically light and dark. We will describe the difference between a tint and a shade, using them to paint a 3D object and final painting.

COMPUTING

In computing, the children will explore computing systems and networks, specifically connecting computers through theory and practical use of equipment.

PSHE

Our PSHE topic for this term focuses on families and relationships and how relatives and friends can offer us support in a variety of situations including bereavement. We will also look at manners and stereotypes.

ENGLISH

This term, Willow will explore the narrative text *Leon and the Place Between*. Making links to our history unit, we will be writing letters and diary entries using the *One Boy's War* text. Further curriculum links will be made through our performance and black out poetry unit which focuses on Flanders Field.

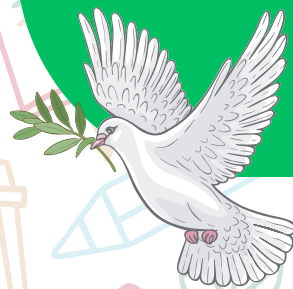
MATHS

The term will begin by deepening our learning on place value using numbers up to 10,000. Following this unit, we will move onto addition and subtraction where children will deepen their learning, using formal written methods for three-digit numbers.

RE

In RE, Willow will explore Creation and Fall within the Big Frieze to ultimately answer the question: 'what do Christians learn from the creation story?'

SCIENCE

In science, we are exploring forces and space, specifically forces and magnets. The children will identify examples of pushes, pulls and twists and define a force, including describing, naming and classifying contact and non-contact forces.

MUSIC

In music, Willow will be participating in music lessons from Entrust where they will learn to play the ukulele! They will also be preparing for the Young Voices concert.

FRENCH

In French, Willow will be using puppets to learn French greetings. They will begin to recognise how some sounds ('on', 'ou', 'et' and 'oi') are represented in written form and take turns to speak and use appropriate intonation.

PE

In PE, Willow will be expanding their learning on fundamental ball skills and increasing their strength through fitness. We will also be having our swimming lessons!
