

## Science

Our topic is “Comparing animals.” We will be comparing and grouping animals based on similarities and differences in their characteristics, physical features and diets. We will also be working scientifically and recognising different ways of gathering data.



## English



In English this half term, Class 1 will begin their narrative unit by reading, “Katie’s London.” We will be making predictions, discussing the text and developing our creative writing skills through description. Then we will look at “Paddington’s London” together and explore non-fiction text features to create our own information leaflets about the city.

## P.E

In PE children will be focussing on Target Games and Team Building. In Target Games pupils develop their understanding of the principles of defending and attacking . In Team Building pupils will learn teamwork skills. Including communication and problem solving

## R.E

The question we will answer is “Why does Easter matter to Christians?” We will recognise that God, Incarnation, Gospel and Salvation are part of the ‘big story’ of the Bible. We will tell stories of Holy Week and Easter and make a link with the idea of Salvation (Jesus rescuing people).

## Maths

Year 1 will extend their Place Value knowledge to 50. Year 2 will complete their work on multiplication and division. Both year groups will then complete a measures unit all about length and height. Mastering Number will continue for everyone.

## Geography

What is the weather like in the UK? We will be exploring countries and cities that make up the UK , keeping a daily weather record and finding out more about hot and cold places.

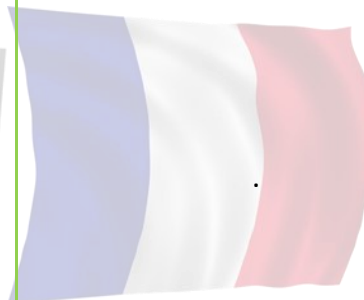
## Spring Term 2 Curriculum – Class 1

## Music

Our unit of work is called “On the island” and is about British songs and sounds. We will create sounds to represent three landscapes: seaside, countryside and city.

## Computing

Computing this term will focus on Data and Information and grouping data in different ways. Children will sort objects into different groups, based on the properties they choose.



## PSHE

Our PSHE theme this half-term is Economic Wellbeing. We will learn about what money is, how people make money and spending or saving choices.
