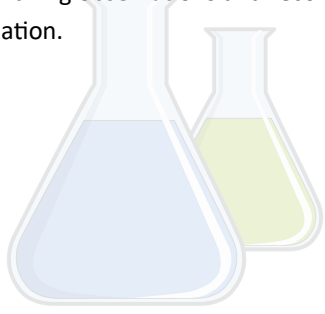


## Science

Our topic is "Sensitive Bodies." Children will draw and label human body parts and explore their five senses, completing simple tests, making observations and recording information.



## English

We will link our English and History work by planning our own adventure stories based on "The Way Back Home." We will continue to focus on capital letters, full stops and using joining words to link ideas and extend sentences. Then the children will use their knowledge to create a fact file about a famous space explorer.



## Maths

Year 1 will extend their Place Value and addition and subtraction knowledge to 20. Year 2 will develop their money, multiplication and division skills. We will all continue to develop our number bond recall through the Mastering Number initiative.

## Computing

Using Beebots, this term children will be introduced to early programming concepts. They will explore using individual commands, both with other learners and as part of a computer program. They will identify what each command for the floor robot does.

## RE

The question we will answer is "What do Hindus believe?"

We will explore the concept of God for Hindus and how they are represented. We will look at the festivals of Diwali and Holi and the importance of music and dance in worship.

## Music

Linked to our Space topic in History and English, children will develop knowledge and understanding of dynamics, timbre, tempo and instruments. They will learn to compose and play simple motifs.

## Spring Term 1 Curriculum – Class One

## PSHE

Through our Citizenship unit we will consider why we have rules; identifying similarities and differences between ourselves and others. Children will begin to understand how voting gives a democratic decision and how the school council works; learning how to share opinions on an issue.

## History

In History we will answer the question "How have explorers changed the world?" This will be linked directly to our English text focus. Children will be finding out about events and people beyond living memory, particularly thinking about explorers and what makes them significant.

## P.E

Our PE lessons will focus on fundamental skills of balancing, running, changing direction, jumping, hopping and skipping. In addition we will develop our yoga skill and begin to learn poses and techniques that will help to connect mind and body.

## Design Technology

Children will learn about the key parts of a wheeled vehicle, to develop an understanding of how wheels, axles and axle holders work. They will design and make a moving vehicle.
