Science

Our unit this half term is 'energy: circuits, batteries and switches' in this unit, children will learn how to create a complete circuit and understand the elements required to create this.

They will learn about the impact different batteries have on a circuit, looking at changing different variables in practical experiments.



In RE this Half term, children will be exploring the question, 'what difference does the resurrection make to Christians'? In this unit, children will explore the importance of the Easter story for Christians and how these events link to the Christian concepts of sacrifice, incarnation and resurrection.

Music

This half term, we will be learning about music from South and West Africa. Children will listen to, appraise and attempt to recreate music in this style.

English

During our first English unit we will be reading the story, 'The Explorer.

As part of this unit, children will explore using figurative language to create descriptions on the Amazon rainforest. Through this, they will explore the impact on the reader that word choices have in creating an image in the mind. After developing their understanding of the text, children will plan and write their own sequal to the story. We will have a focus on using dialogue to convey character and look at using a range of varying sentence structures.

In the second part of the term, we will be looking at writing balanced arguments, considering the human impact on rainforest environments.

<u>PSHE</u>

Our unit in PSHE is "Economic wellbeing'. In this unit, children will learn about the importance of budgeting, saving and sensible spending.
