Our topic this term is 'Ourselves'

Literacy:

The children will be developing early reading skills, learning the letter sounds in phonics, and will gain the passion and confidence needed to develop early writing skills through our Drawing Club lessons.

Mathematics:

We will be developing understanding of numbers, counting, and learning mathematical concepts such as sorting, pairing, measuring and weighing. We will use the Numberblocks series to support learning.

Communication and Language:

We will be working on developing the children's abilities to listen, understand, and express themselves effectively through conversation and storytelling.
