

Children in Reception follow the Foundation Stage Curriculum. This is split into seven areas of learning. We predominately learn through play in a hands on practical way. Our topic this term is '**Celebrations**'

Literacy:

The children will continue to learn phase 2 letter sounds in phonics and begin to blend the sounds into words. They will build confidence with letter formation and segmenting words to write.

Mathematics:

We will develop their confidence at subitising and understanding of numbers up to 5; representing, composing and comparing. We will focus on mathematical concepts such as; 2D shape properties and positional language.

Communication and Language:

We will be working on developing the children's abilities to ask questions (what?, who?). Children will know and use new vocabulary linked to our festivals, including Diwali.

Understanding the world:

Children will be learning about the world around them. We will be discussing people, communities, and the past and present. This will include key celebrations at this time of year, such as; Diwali, Bonfire Night and Christmas.

Physical Development:

We will develop both gross motor skills (balance, climbing) and fine motor skills (holding a pencil, using tools, forming letters).

We will be learning to interact positively and listen to others, valuing each others differences. We will focus on how to keep ourselves safe and healthy.

Expressive Arts and Design:
