

Learning Project Autumn Term 1 – Me and my World/ International Term

Age Range: EYFS

Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Watch a Numberblocks clip each day at: [BBC](#) or [CBeebies](#). (Use this guide [here](#) to give you ideas on what to do with your children whilst watching an episode.)
- Set the table and count the cutlery.
- Help to match the socks which have been washed. Which are the longest? Who do they belong to? Can you find socks which have a pattern? Can you continue that pattern?
- Tidy up the shoes and put in order of size. Who has the longest, shortest feet?
- Draw around the shoes and write the size. Can you read the number?
- Draw around your feet. Count your toes. Write numbers 1 to 5 one number on each toe.

Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Read a variety of books at home. (Favourites can be repeated. Hearing the patterns of language in a story will support your child's language development.)
- Retell your favourite story. Act out your favourite story.
- What is your favourite part of the story? Draw or paint a picture and tell the adults why it is your favourite part, remember to start your sentence by saying... 'My favourite part is because.....'
- Can you sing nursery rhymes? How many do you know?
- Can you think of words that rhyme with:
 - Wall
 - Chair
 - Mat
- Can you read and write key words:
 - I
 - no
 - go
 - to
 - the

Perhaps you could hide them in the garden and ask the adults to find them. Did they get it right?

Weekly Phonics Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Ask your child to hide a bear and to tell you where it is by breaking the word down into each unit of sound, e.g. i..n m...igh b..e..d
- Daily phonics - Practice these sounds:
 - s, a, t, p,
 - m, l, n, d
 - g, o, c, k,

Blend words. This can be oral blending (e.g. spoken out loud c-a-t) or written.
- Cut up lengths of string or thread. Show your child a letter or tricky word and ask them to 'make it' using the thread. It will be tricky!
- Use playdough and make each letter and say the sound.

Weekly Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Practise mark making.
 - Have funky fingers and use the dough to pinch, squeeze and to stretch. Play a song and try to do exercises using your fingers all the way through the song. Do they ache?
 - Write the 'KEY WORDS' from above. Can you use them in a sentence? What is your sentence? Draw a picture to match the sentence.
 - Practise writing letters, forming them correctly.

 - Make a list of resources needed to keep clean and healthy
 - Draw a picture of themselves with different hair colour and style
 - Find, cut out and stick pictures of different hairstyles
 - Discuss how we have similarities but we all have our own identities.

Learning Project - to be done throughout the week

- **Get Creative**
 - Find some objects from your favourite story.
 - Retell the story using the objects.
- **Odd one out**
 - Sorting socks. Choose your own criteria for sorting. It might be by colour, shape or size. You might choose 2 sets of criteria.
 - Which ones are left? Why?
- **Taller or shorter?**
 - Build a tower. Can you make it as tall as, shorter than, taller than you?
 - Count the bricks.
 - Draw around someone who is taller than you. Who is it?
- **Be a superhero. 'How can I help?'**
 - Could you help to make a sandwich?
 - Help with the washing up after a mealtime.
 - Tidy your room and put away your toys when asked.
 - Create your own compost bin using a cardboard box filled with leaves and waste.
 - Check it and see what happens. REMEMBER TO WASH YOUR HANDS!

- **Where in the World.....**
 - Look at a World map and find different countries. Find where you live.
 - Go on a walk around the garden. Draw a map and add the things you see.
 - Find leaves from different trees, talk about the shape, the colour and the size. Paint them and print.
- **Dingle Dangle Scarecrow**

- **Art sculpture**
 - Make stick people using outdoor materials.
 - SCARECROWS- Use an old wooden spoon or some sticks fastened together. Wrap wool or any other scrap material around the frame.
- **Create a reading den outside using blankets and cushions covered with sheets or tarpaulin. Have a selection of fiction and non-fiction books available.**
