Addition

In our maths lessons, the children have been introduced to the concept of addition and have been exploring the 'First, then, now' model. In EYFS our focus is on understanding of the concept and we work with practical objects. Children are exposed to what a written calculation looks like (e.g. $3 + 2 = 5$).
