FIRE PROCEDURES

Anyone who discovers a fire should sound the nearest alarm and send a responsible adult to ask the Office Team to phone the fire service.

ON HEARING THE ALARM THE PRIORITY IS TO CLEAR THE BUILDING

The fire alarm will ring in either Manser and Benton Buildings. The Office Team will inform Copper Class (Communication and Interaction Resource Base), the Heritage Building and the swimming pool if in use. In the event of a fire in the Copper Class building, Heritage Building or Swimming Pool, a member of Copper Class/Heritage/Pool Staff must inform the school office.

Keep calm and direct the children to leave the building via the nearest fire exit. Noone must attempt to collect possessions. Teachers/Supervisor in charge will take the Attendance Register or the class lists hanging in the PE store if the children are in the hall. The Office Team will take the Visitor Ipad to the assembly point.

Children and adults must go out in single file through the nearest Fire Exit ensuring that the outside door is closed behind them. Once outside, any children detached from their own class should be sent to join it at the assembly point. An adult must ensure that no child has been left behind. The toilets must be checked and all other areas where children may be working.

For Ladybird Pre-school, the emergency key to the EYFS gate is located in the box under the canopy.

The children should walk in silence to the assembly point and line up in class order.

ASSEMBLY POINT

For <u>all</u> children and adults on site, the Assembly Point is located on the <u>middle</u> <u>playground by the end of the swimming pool.</u>

As soon as the class is assembled in a single line, the class teacher will check everyone is present by a head count. If a child appears to be missing, the register will be called. All reasonable steps, under the direction of the Headteacher or Assistant Headteachers, will be taken to search the premises for any missing persons.

Class teachers will raise an arm to indicate that everyone is accounted for.

No one will leave the assembly point until the proper checks have been made and the Headteacher (or in the Head's absence, the Assistant Headteacher) gives permission.
