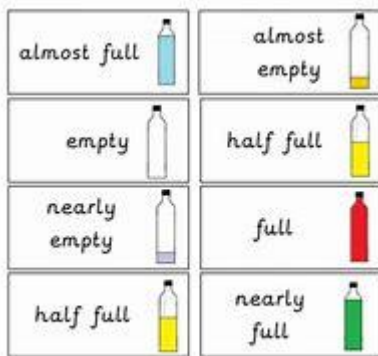


Dear Parents/Carers,

### Communication and Language

Where did Mary and Joseph stay?

What presents did they bring?  
Challenge: what did they lay the baby in?
