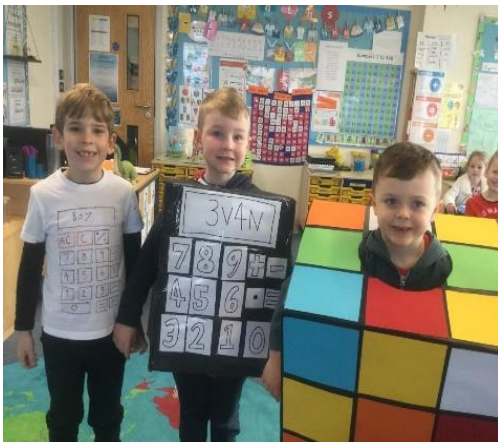
Our Vision:
