
Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 3 have been exploring coding with LEGO WeDo, building models and programming them to carry out different tasks. The children used problem-solving, logical thinking and perseverance as they tested, debugged and improved their designs. They also developed teamwork and communication skills by working collaboratively and sharing ideas.



Year 6 have been investigating shelters in DT. They have been finding creative and inventive ways to build protection from elements and ensure survival. Here are some food inspired shelters with luxury living spaces situated inside of each food item!





Year 5 have embraced their new science topic for this term: 'Properties and Changes of Materials'. The children enjoyed creating circuits to determine which materials were electrical insulators and which were electrical conductors.

Year 1 have been learning all about the five oceans of the world and, during their PE lesson this week, the year group came together to explore ways of moving like sea creatures to music and creating static shapes to represent coral. This developed their listening skills, creative movement and gave them an opportunity to partner with peers across the year group.
