Music

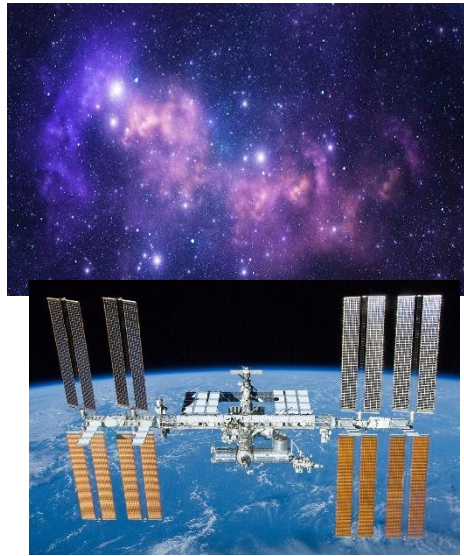
We will be exploring Christmas music through our topic song 'Ho, Ho, Ho'.
