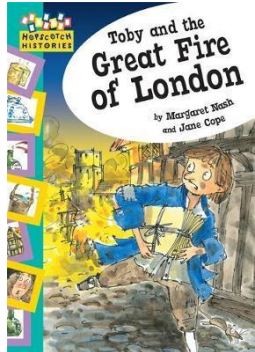


## Literacy

## Topic

The Great Fire of London.  
We will be learning about when this historical event happened within British History. We will learn about the events leading up to the fire and different viewpoints from the people who lived through it. We will also think about how fire safety has changed.

### Statistics

We will be learning to collect data and record it using tally charts and pictograms.

### Fractions

We will recognise, find, name and write fractions  $\frac{1}{3}$ ,  $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $\frac{2}{4}$  and  $\frac{3}{4}$ , and write simple fractions for example,  $\frac{1}{2}$  of 6 = 3 and recognise the equivalence of  $\frac{2}{4}$  and  $\frac{1}{2}$ .
