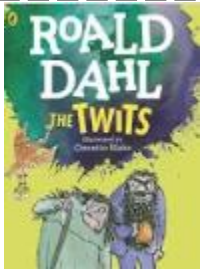
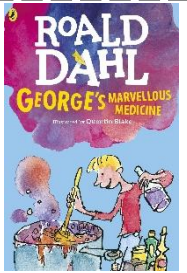


Literacy
