RE

Maths

Number: Fractions We will recognise, find, name and write fractions $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$. and write simple fractions for example, $\frac{1}{2}$ of 6 = 3 and recognise the equivalence of $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$.

Geometry: Position and Direction

We will order and arrange combinations of mathematical objects in patterns and sequences. Use mathematical vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement, including movement in a straight line and distinguishing between rotation as a turn and in terms of right angles for quarter, half and three-quarter turns (clockwise and anticlockwise).

Topic

We will be learning about the rainforest. We will look at the climate and weather of rainforests around the world as well as animals found in the 4 different layers of the rainforest.

Computing

We will be using Purple Mash to assist us with effective searching when looking for information. We will look at search engines and how to use them as well as how to filter results.
