

PE

We will continue with swimming sessions on a Friday. In their other session each week the children will be practising their athletics skills.

Maths

This term we will be recapping everything learnt so far and looking at measures including Time.

The children will:

- Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction; mass; temperature; capacity to the nearest appropriate unit.
- Compare and order lengths, mass, volume/capacity and record the results using $>$, $<$ and $=$.
- Compare and sequence intervals of time.
- Tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour.
- Know the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day.

Collective Worship

Whole school Collective Worship will be on a Friday and KS1 Collective Worship on Tuesday and Wednesday, they will focus on our value.
