PE

Maths

This term we will be looking at measures including Time. The children will:

- Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction; mass; temperature; capacity to the nearest appropriate unit.
- Compare and order lengths, mass, volume/capacity and record the results using >,< and =.
- Compare and sequence intervals of time.
- Tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour.
- Know the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day.
