**Focus:** We will look at the chronology of WW1 and significant related events (including the Christmas truce)

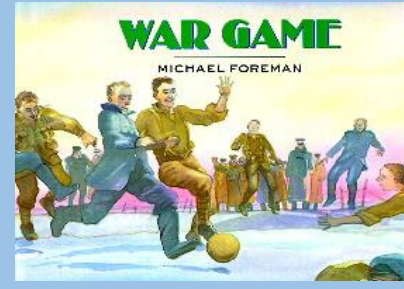
## Spreadsheets
