Science - Pupil led investigations:

<u>https://sciencebob.com/build-a-fizz-inflator/</u> - create a bottle fizz inflator! You will need One small empty plastic soda or water bottle, 1/2 cup of vinegar, Small balloon, Baking soda and Funnel or piece of paper.

<u>Art</u>: - Look at dinosaur images online. Look at the shapes and patterns that make up their bodies. Create a line drawing of a dinosaur and then use a media of your choice to add colour and texture.

<u>History</u>: Watch the two powerpoints on what is a dinosaur and a dinosaur timeline. Pick a time period and draw and name a dinosaur from that time period.

Easter occurs in Spring and is very important to Christians. What do you know about Easter and what does it mean to you? Can you draw a picture and/or write a sentence about Easter?

 Fairtrade and You'.
- Use Google Maps or an atlas to travel around the world! Can you find a country where cocoa grows? Check the temperature in that country today. What was the temperature in that country 50 years ago? Has it changed? If so, why?
- Bake a difference! With an adult, bake or cook using at least one Fairtrade ingredient. Can you decorate your creation with the Fairtrade mark?
