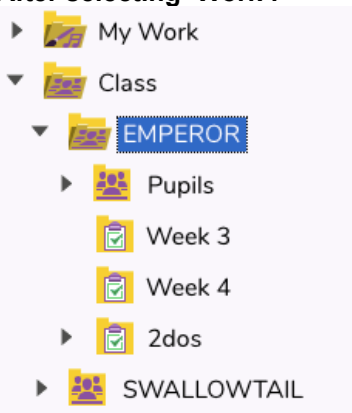
Purple Mash

Science – Pupil led investigations:

Art: Look at images of dinosaur skeletons in books and online and notice shapes and structure - Create a dinosaur skeleton image/ sculpture using:

- 1 - art straws on black paper
- 2 - chalk on black paper
- 3 – dried pasta on coloured paper
- 4 – pipe cleaner model

Discuss

Do you remember where Lyme Regis is? Could you point to it on a map? What is a fossil? Do you remember the name of the swirl shaped fossil they found on the beach?

Have a go drawing or making your own fossil. You can use the instructions on Purple Mash, draw your own or use the colouring sheets.

RE - Christianity:

Our big question this term is 'Why was Jesus welcomed like a King on Palm Sunday?'

Look at the resources on Purple Mash about the Easter Story. Draw a picture showing the key parts of the Easter story adding labels and captions.

PSHE:

- This week we are thinking about healthy eating. What sort of foods do you think are healthy for our body? Are there any foods that we need to avoid eating lots of? Which foods do you like/dislike? Choose some of these activities to complete:
 - Have a fruit and vegetable tasting – does everyone in your family like the same things?
 - Make fruit kebabs or fruit faces
 - Complete the healthy packed lunch activity sheet on Purple Mash by drawing the foods you put in a balanced lunchbox.

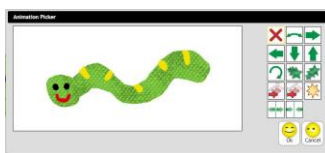
