

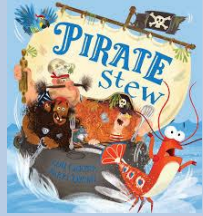
Literacy

Poetry: On a Theme: Pirates

Non-Fiction: Letters: Identify key features of letters and postcards. Write a letter to send as a message in a bottle.
