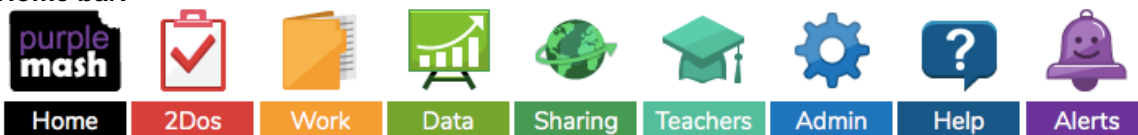
Extra Daily Support

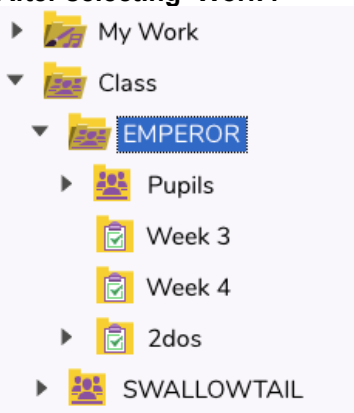
Purple Mash

You can also click '2Dos' for any new set. If you click on 'Work', then use the arrow drop-downs to select your class, then you can find your own folder where you can save things, your completed 2Dos, and a weekly folder where we save resources. If you search for the app '2Email' you will be able to access your child's emails. Please make sure you check these for any key updates or information from your teacher.

These activities reflect our new topic of 'Pirates'.

Science – Wonderful Weather

- Look at weather forecasts and the symbols used by forecasters.
- Go on a winter walk, take some photos of what you notice, muddy paths, bare trees, frost covered leaves.
- Draw a winter picture and write words/sentences to describe what you see outside.

Art

- Create an under the sea picture using media of your choice, could be pencil, pen, chalk, oil pastel, paint or a mixture. Focus on colours and shapes and try to add lots of different sea creatures.
