### **Extra Daily Support**

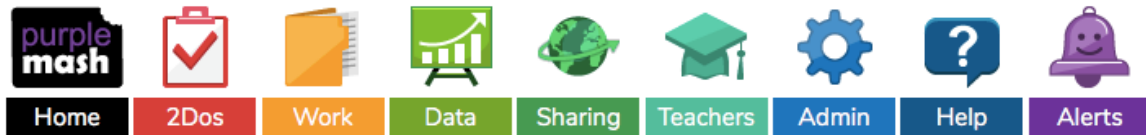

### **Purple Mash**

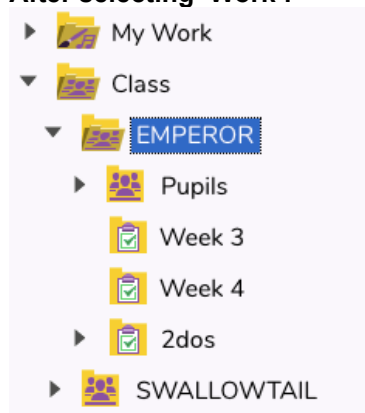

### **Weekly Writing / Literacy Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)**

- Identify symbols on a map.
- Stain paper with tea and create a pirates map with different symbols and an x for where the treasure is.

- Write clues and directions for your treasure map to direct the pirate to the treasure.
- Describe the features on the treasure map.

## **Topic Learning Projects- To be done throughout the week**

These activities reflect our new topic of 'Pirates'.

### **Science – Wonderful Weather**

- Keep watching the weather forecast this week. Think about how weather forecasters and scientists measure the weather. Look at the 'Weather Stations' pp for ideas.
- Make a rain gauge – this is how we measure rainfall. Follow the instructions on the worksheet.
- Record your daily results from your rain gauge. Compare the days – which day had the least rain and which day had the most rain? Did the weather forecast get it right?

### **Art**

- Look at more artwork by Robert Wyland.
- Have a go at copying 1 of his paintings.  
Go on a walk and collect natural objects from outside, then create your own sea picture or sea sculpture using what you have found.

### **Geography:**

- Invent your own island and think about what type of pirates would visit your island. Include different wildlife and nature that would live on your island.

### **RE – Christianity:**

**Our big question this term is 'How did Jesus show friendship?'**

- Jesus chose people from all backgrounds to be his friends and disciples. Draw a picture of a friend and write what you like about them.

### **PSHE:**

- What can we do to look after our house and the things in it? Ask a member of your family what you could do to help around your house. Draw or take a picture of you helping out at home.

### **Computing:**
