MATHS

We will learn about money, statistics, length and perimeter. In statistics we will look at tally charts, bar charts and pictograms. When we study length we will look at measuring in mm, cm and metres, and learn how to find perimeters.

In mental arithmetic we will practise how to add and subtract small groups of numbers, e.g., 7 + 8 - 4.

SCIENCE

We will be carrying out investigations in science, designed to help the children understand how to set up a fair test and use the results to find a conclusion.

Our value this term is 'compassion'. We will hear inspiring stories and Bible teachings and then reflect on the importance of this value in our lives.

ICT

We will learn how to send and open emails, adding attachments and what to look for in suspicious email addresses. We will explore an email scenario and learn how to be safer online.

ENGLISH

We will learn about the features of play scripts and how to write dialogues based on Second World War themed stories and films. The children will practise their speaking and listening skills by performing improvisations.

We will also study recounts of events, using 'The Hodgeheg' as our text. The children will write a diary entry and a newspaper report based on the story. We will learn about the present perfect tense.
