

Maths SG4

We will be exploring place value, addition and subtraction this term. Reading, writing and representing numbers up to 1000, comparing numbers, finding 10 or 100 more or less than a given number. We will look at adding multiples of ten to three digit numbers, estimating answers and using the inverse to check.

Music SG4

Violin – Our peripatetic teacher, Ms Scoles, will be back to teach the children in Europe class. Asia will learn songs from 'Charanga' music scheme.
