Maths SG4


We will be exploring place value, addition and subtraction this term. Reading, writing and representing numbers up to 1000, comparing numbers, finding 10 or 100 more or less than a given number. We will look at adding multiples of ten to three digit numbers, estimating answers and using the inverse to check. Every Friday we have a times tables challenge. The children will practise rapid recall of addition and subtraction facts to 20.

Music SG4

Science SG4
